## **Treasurer's Report for year ending 31<sup>st</sup> October 2008**

### **NAIRNSHIRE FARMING SOCIETY TREASURER'S REPORT TO BE PRESENTED AT THE AGM TO BE HELD ON 20<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2009**

I have completed my three year term as Treasurer and I am presenting my Final Report in that capacity to the Annual General Meeting. The new Treasurer for the Society is Karen Young and Karen will be introduced to Members at the Meeting. I will attend to deal with any queries on the Society's finances and Accounts which I have prepared for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> October 2008. The figures for this year with comparatives for the previous year are represented by a Receipts and Payments Account copied herewith. With reference to these Accounts, in accordance with the statutory provisions monitored by the Office of Scottish Charities Regulator, an Independent Examiner's Report is necessary. The external Examiner appointed by the Committee is Jimmy Somerville and copies of his Reports on the Receipts and Payments Account for both 2007 and 2008 will be made available to Members at the AGM.

It is with regret that, as Treasurer preparing the Accounts for the transactions for years ended 31<sup>st</sup> October 2006, 2007 and 2008, that deficits have arisen in each of these years. It is clear that the costs of presenting the Annual Show which have been increasing to maintain standards which we have come to expect by tradition have been increasing and that the level of charges for admissions and for exhibitors will have to be re-considered by the Committee.

In my term as Treasurer, the Society suffered adverse weather conditions in 2007 resulting in a drop of admissions of between £5,000 and £10,000 compared to earlier years and the extra costs involved in staging Nairn Show 2008 on a new virgin site were only partly set-off by an increase in income from admissions compared to 2007.

The task of organising the managing the Annual Show is devolved on Nairn Show Ltd, a Company which is wholly owned by the Society. The Company has not been able to build up cash reserves and, as a result, financial support to cover the deficits has had to be given by the Society.

I recommend that Members attending the AGM take the opportunity of putting forward ideas which will improve the Society's finances.

I wish to thank all those who provided assistance to myself as Treasurer particularly those involved on the day of the Show. I wish Karen Young, your new Treasurer, well and hope that she gets the appropriate support from the Committee in the vital job of balancing expenditure with income.
